Parent / Guardian Permission: I the parent/guardian of the above named participant hereby give my approval for participation in any and all of the activities of the Redmond Football Association during the season. I assume all risks and hazards, incidental to the conduct of any of the activities, including transportation to and from such activities. I do further release, absolve, indemnify and hold harmless the Redmond Football Association, its organizers, sponsors, directors and supervisors, and any or all of them, in the case of injury to my child. I hereby waive all claims against the organizers, sponsors, directors and supervisors appointed by RFA. I likewise waive, to the extent not covered by liability insurance, any claim against any person transporting my child to and from the activities.

Emergency Medical Authorization: I the parent/guardian of the above named participant, hereby give my authorization for any emergency medical treatment of the participant for any injury resulting from any activity of the Redmond Football Association including transportation to or from such activity. It is understood that efforts shall be made to contact the undersigned prior to rendering treatment to the injured participant. This authorization will expire on 12/31/11.

Refunds: No refunds. Payment in full is due BEFORE July 1, 2011.

Equipment: Each participant will be loaned the following equipment: A helmet with face mask and chin strap, shoulder pads, socks, mouth guard and game belts. Game jerseys are kept by the individual at the end of the season. Players must provide their own padded football girdles (hip, tailbone and thigh pads), knee pads, game pants ('vegas gold' only) and shoes, which should be all-purpose football/soccer shoes with molded sole rubber cleats. Metal cleats or removable cleats are not permitted. Each player is required to clean on a regular basis and return all loaned equipment at the end of the season. Players must notify their coach immediately if any equipment is damaged or lost during the season, so it may be replaced. Replacement costs will be assessed to each player for lost equipment. The amounts will be as follows: helmet \$150, shoulder pads \$85, practice jersey \$15, belts \$10. Total = \$ 260.00. Helmets that have been neglected or abused (including adding stickers, decals or tape or the removal of the safety decals) will be assessed a \$50 reconditioning fee or a replacement fee.

Level of Play: Each player will compete with other players of comparable age and weight, by being assigned to a league level through an age/weight formula. It is the position of RFA that it is generally best for each player to play at the lowest level, without any significant weight loss, particularly which occurs in a short term. The decision to attain a certain playing weight and the responsibility of maintaining that weight belong to the player and parent/guardian. Generally, all players should be below their maximum weight for the level for which they desire to play. This would be by the first day of practice. Player's weight will be checked prior to starting their first practice, and before every game throughout the season.

Boys & Girls Club Insurance: The RFA is affiliated with the Greater Eastside Jr. Football Association, which is sponsored by the Boys & Girls Club of Bellevue. The club provides supplemental medical coverage through an accident policy only after benefits are received from the player's primary insurance coverage, or if the player has no other coverage, in which case the Boys & Girls Club policy will serve as primary coverage. The maximum benefits are \$50,000 medical, and \$100 per tooth dental.

THE PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

The support of parents, both fathers and mothers, is essential to the success of any youth program. This support, however, should be of the off-field variety in such activities as fund-raising, promotion, equipment maintenance, team sponsorship and other volunteer activities.

Greater Eastside Junior Football Association (GEJFA) and the Redmond Football Association (RFA) are comprised entirely of volunteers. Coaches, administrators and other volunteers spend hundreds of hours of their time in the off-season as well as during the season to provide a tackle football program for your children.

Overzealous, but well-meaning, parents can cause unwarranted problems if they are not familiar with the policies and philosophies of the youth football association. The RFA has rules concerning the conduct of parents. Below is the code of conduct that the RFA parents should follow:

1. Parents should clearly understand that the aim of youth football is to teach their children teamwork, good sportsmanship, fair play and a love for the sport of football.
2. Parents should understand that alcohol and the use of drugs at practices or games are strictly prohibited.
3. Parents should insist on a safe and healthy environment for their children to practice and compete.
 1. Parents must stay in the areas designated by the local association during all practice sessions. Parents (except parent/coaches) are never allowed on the practice field during practice unless authorized by the coaching staff.
 2. Parents are not allowed on the sidelines or playing field at the games. All spectators must remain in the stands. Only players, coaches, and appointed association officials may be on the sidelines or track in the front of the stands during the games, unless authorized by the coaching or administration staff.
4. Parents should encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports event.
 1. Youth football is not professional football. Parents should cheer hard and loud for their team, but your fan support must be kept in the proper perspective and always in good taste.
 2. Unsportsmanlike conduct in the stands during games is prohibited and can result in penalties to the team / head coach on the field as well as possible expulsion from future events.
 3. Derogatory statements towards game officials or the opposing team are prohibited and may result in the forfeiture of a game and/or suspension of the head coach as well as possible expulsion from future events.
5. Parents should work with the RFA board (outlined on the system website) to resolve issues with the coaching staff.
 1. RFA coaches are held to the GEJFA code of conduct (<http://www.gejfa.org/pdfs/codeofconduct.pdf>) and it is the right and responsibility of the parents to ensure that their coaching staff is upholding this code of conduct.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO ALWAYS HAVE A POSITIVE AND SUPPORTIVE ATTITUDE FOR YOUR PLAYER.
